## **Apply to Join the Tri-City Mental Health Commission**

Tri-City Mental Health Center was formed in 1960 as a provider of community mental health services to low-income residents of Claremont, La Verne and Pomona. The Mental Health Commission is a state mandated body comprised of community members and consumers committed to the effective and consumer-sensitive delivery of mental health services.

Tri-City is seeking applications from members of the community, consumers of mental health services, and family members of these consumers to participate on their Mental Health Commission. Some of the duties includes (a) to review and evaluate the area's mental health needs, services, facilities and special problems, (b) to advise the Tri-City Governing Board and the Executive Director as to any aspects of Tri-City's mental health program, (c) to review and approve the agency's procedures in order to ensure citizen and professional involvement at all stages of the mental health planning process, (d) to review and make recommendations on applicants for the appointment of the agency's director of mental health services, among others.
