What kind of information do we collect?

We may collect some or all of the following information about you: your name, address, birth date, some financial information and information about your health. We may also ask you for your medical history, medications you may be taking and any health problems you may have, for the purpose of providing quality health care services.

What do we do with this information?

We use information about you to determine if you are eligible to participate in this program. It may also help us in making an appropriate referral and assist us in your treatment. Safeguarding your health information is important to us.

Who else can see your information?

We may disclose information about you only as permitted by law.

We provide a full range of services including:

- + Mental health counseling
- + Case management
- + Individual and group therapy
- + Crisis intervention
- + Mental health, co-occurring and substance use support
- + School-based services
- + Psychiatric medication support
- + Specialized infant mental health services for ages birth to 5 years
- + Linkage and referral to community resources, such as supportive housing, transportation, financial and health care assistance

School-Based Mental Health Services

School-based services are provided at designated school sites. Clinicians in our School Partnership Team are available during specified times to conduct assessments, determine medical necessity and enroll students in appropriate services. Our team will also assist in linking youth with resources as well as provide on-site collateral and family sessions, as needed.

Who is eligible to receive services?

A child or youth aged 25 or younger who:

- Has Los Angeles County Medi-Cal
- Resides in Pomona, Claremont or La Verne
- Experiences emotional or psychological concerns that affect their personal well-being and impact their ability to participate and function in family, relationships, work, school, community or other daily activities
